Physiotherapy Education:

The Luxembourg association does not have an education department. There are no physiotherapy schools or universities in the country so physiotherapy students undergo courses in other Member States. Every year +- 10 students from Luxembourg are graduated in other countries (3-4 years of training). Physiotherapists are however involved in research in Luxembourg. There is no recognition of physiotherapy specialists.

Professional Title/ Qualification: Masseur - Kinésithérapeute Dipl. The title and the professional activity is protected by the state.
